

## Fishery Products, 2023

### Fishery production increased by 18.6% in 2023

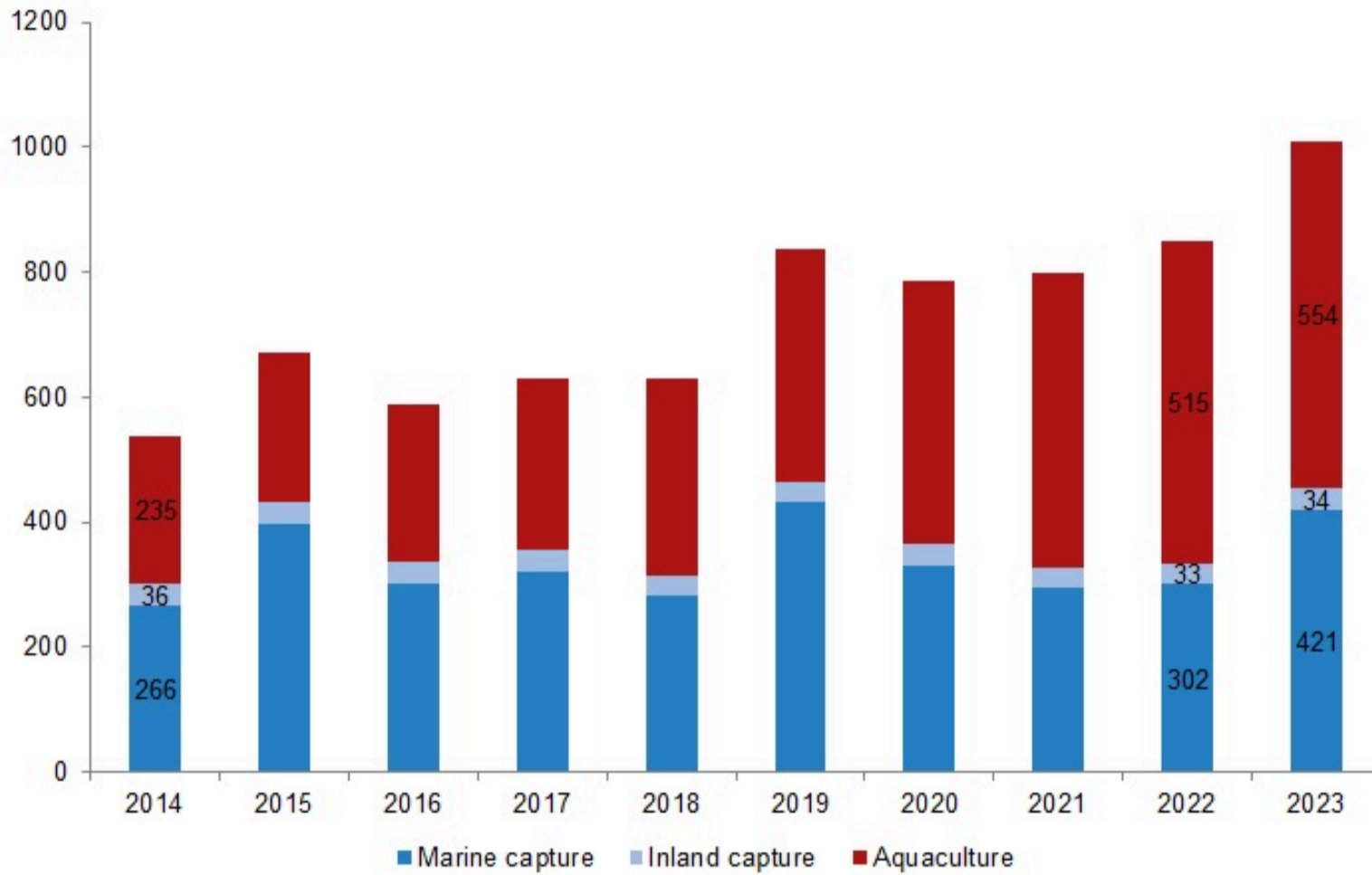
Fishery production increased by 18.6% in 2023 with respect to the previous year and occurred as 1 million 7 thousand 921 tonnes. The total fishery production was composed of caught sea fish by 38.4%, caught other sea products by 3.3%, caught inland water products by 3.3% and aquaculture products by 55.0%.

### In 2023, capture of fishery products increased by 35.5%

While the production made by capture was 454 thousand 59 tonnes, aquaculture production occurred as 553 thousand 862 tonnes. The capture of marine products increased by 39.4%, capture of inland water products increased by 0.8% with respect to the previous year.

The quantity of the capture of sea fish occurred 387 thousand 115 tonnes. When the distribution of the capture of sea fish examined, it was seen that the highest amount of fish is anchovy with 273 thousand 915 tonnes. Sprat with 45 thousand 764 tonnes and pilchard with 17 thousand 311 tonnes followed the anchovy.
