Suspension Polyvinyl Chloride (S-PVC) originating in China,
Mexico and South Korea

Notification of Proposed Sample

In accordance with Regulations 56 and 57 of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (“D&S Regs”) the TRA considers it appropriate to limit its examination to a sample of overseas exporters and importers. The TRA is not intending to limit its examination of UK producers.

In accordance with regulation 56(4) of the D&S Regs the TRA publishes this notification to provide details of its sampling approach and the proposed sample of overseas exporters and importers. The TRA invites overseas exporters and importers to provide comments regarding the sampling methodology and the proposed sample by 23 September 2026. The TRA will consider these comments before publishing a final sampling decision.

All sampled interested parties included in the final sample will be expected to provide adequate responses to questionnaires and allow the TRA to verify the data provided.

Importer sampling

Based on the information available to the TRA, the proposed sample comprises the following importers:

1. Anonymous importer
2. Amtico International

In accordance with Regulation 56(3) of the D&S Regs the proposed sample is based on the largest volume of exports from China, Mexico and South Korea to the UK that the TRA is reasonably able to investigate.

In accordance with regulation 54(4) D&S Regs, the TRA shall limit the issuing of a questionnaire to those importers included in the final sample.



Overseas exporter sampling

Based on the information available to the TRA, the proposed sample comprises the following overseas exporters:

1. Wanhua Group
 - Wanhua Group Chemical Group (Yantai) Olefins Co., Ltd. (China)
 - Wanhua Chemical (Fujian) Co., Ltd. (China)
 - Wanhua Chemical (Singapore) Pte. Ltd (China)
2. Tianjin Bohua Chemical Development Co., Ltd. (China)
3. Mexichem Resinas Vinilicas S.A. de C.V. (Mexico)
4. Hanwha Solutions Corporation (South Korea)
5. LG Chem, Ltd (South Korea)

In accordance with Regulation 56(3) of the D&S Regs, the proposed sample is based on the largest volume of exports from China, Mexico and South Korea to the UK that the TRA is reasonably able to investigate.

In accordance with regulation 54(4) of the D&S Regs, the TRA shall limit the issuing of a questionnaire to those overseas exporters included in the final sample.

UK producer sampling

Based on the information available to the TRA, the TRA does not consider it appropriate to limit its examination to a sample of UK producers. In accordance with regulation 54(2)(b) of the D&S Regs, the following UK producer identified in the Application has been issued a questionnaire:

1. INOVYN ChlorVinyls Limited¹
