Introduction

We invite interested parties and contributors to register their interest in this review by submitting a completed registration form.

This registration form is for **overseas exporters**. If you are not an overseas exporter, please download and complete the relevant registration form from the public file (public-file.trade-remedies.service.gov.uk/case/ir0093) if you wish to provide information as part of this review.

To register to this case, you need to provide both a confidential and a non-confidential version of this form. Your non-confidential version should be as similar as possible to your confidential version except for the redaction of the confidential information.

Both copies must be returned to the TRA by **04 August 2026** via the Trade Remedies Service (portal.trade-remedies.service.gov.uk). It is your responsibility to ensure the non-confidential version – which may be placed on the public file – does not contain any confidential information, which includes personal contact information, names and signatures.¹

All information provided to the TRA in confidence will be treated as confidential in accordance with regulation 45 of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations) and will not be disclosed (except in limited circumstance as permitted by regulation 46 of the Regulations) and will be stored in protected systems.

This form allows us to collect basic information about your company. If a large number of exporters complete this form, we may only ask a sample of exporters to complete a detailed questionnaire. By submitting this completed registration form, you agree that you may be included in any such sample. If your company is included in the sample, you will be asked to respond to the questions in the detailed [questionnaire](#) and to support the TRA in [verifying](#) your responses. This may involve the TRA carrying out a verification visit to your premises.

If you indicate that you do not agree to possible inclusion in a sample, your company may be deemed not to have cooperated in the review. The TRA will base its findings for non-cooperating parties on facts available. This may result in an outcome that is less favourable to your company than if it had cooperated.

Top Collection maintains its position that no PMS exists in the PRC market for the goods subject to review. Nevertheless, without prejudice to this position, if the TRA considers it necessary to identify a representative third country, Top Collection provides the following preliminary comments.

To our current knowledge, Thailand is one of the countries where similar goods are produced and may be considered as a possible representative third country. However, further assessment would be required regarding production processes, raw materials, product mix, manufacturing costs and market conditions before any representative country could be identified.

Given that this review is still at an early stage and the information currently available is limited, Top Collection reserves the right to submit further comments once additional information becomes available.
