The GOC reiterate that, there is no particular market situation in the Chinese ceramic tableware and kitchenware market. Both the prices for domestic sale and export are made by market forces and there is no barter trade in the Chinese market.

In such circumstances, the TRA may determine normal value using the costs of production plus a reasonable amount for administrative, selling, and general costs and for profits. The TRA may make adjustments to those costs and profits using data from an appropriate representative third country, if it determines that any relevant costs or profits of the overseas exporter are unrepresentative of what these costs or profits would be in a market where these were substantially determined by market forces.

We invite you to suggest an appropriate representative third country, should the TRA need to make such adjustments. Please provide supporting explanation or evidence to justify why you assess your proposed country to be appropriate. If you have contact details for a producer in your proposed country who may be willing to participate in the review, please also provide this information here.
