



NOTICE OF FINDINGS FOLLOWING REASSESSMENT

Safeguard measure on certain steel products

Suspension Review – Category 1 Steel – Hot Rolled Flat and Coil

Case No. SS0051

On 30 September 2024, the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) provided notice of a request made by the Secretary of State for Business and Trade (the Secretary of State) that the TRA reassess its recommendation to suspend the definitive safeguarding remedy on Category 1 steel products. This request was made pursuant to Regulation 39(9)(b) of the Trade Remedies (Increase in Imports Causing Serious Injury to UK Producers) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (as amended) (the Regulations).

The TRA has now concluded its reassessment and has determined that the conditions which formed the basis for its earlier recommendation to suspend no longer remain.

It therefore gives notice, in accordance with regulation 39(7) of the Regulations, that it no longer considers it appropriate to recommend suspension of the definitive safeguarding remedy on Category 1 steel products.

The reasons for this determination are set out in the TRA's final report, which is available on the [public file](#).

This notice comes into effect on the date on which it is published and the suspension review, SS0051, on Category 1 steel products is terminated on that date.
