#### Note to the file

This note to the file reports a meeting between members of the Trade Remedies Authority's (TRA) investigations team, with representatives from the UK applicant.

This meeting took place at the request of the applicant on 12 May 2023.

The applicant sought clarification on some areas of the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) published on 26 April 2023: subsidy calculations, injury margin, pass through and next steps.

The applicant was informed that any information provided during the meeting that is material to the investigation must be submitted in writing and placed on the public file (other than confidential information)<sup>1</sup>.
