Note to the file

This note to the file reports a meeting between members of the Trade Remedies Authority's investigations team, representatives from the Department for Business and Trade, and representatives from the Government of the Republic of Türkiye (GoT).

This meeting took place at the request of the GoT on 14 June 2023.

The GoT sought clarification on some areas of the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) published on 26 April 2023:

- the volume of imports from Türkiye;
- the causal link between imports from Türkiye and injury; and
- the choice of period of investigation and injury period.

The GoT was informed that any information provided during the meeting that is material to the investigation must be submitted in writing and placed on the public file (other than confidential information)¹.
