TRANSITION REVIEW No. TD0035

Anti-dumping duties on certain pneumatic tyres used for buses or lorries originating in the People's Republic of China

Notification of proposed sample - exporters

The Trade Remedies Authority has previously notified that the number of responses received in both the registration period and to the pre-sampling questionnaire, means the TRA has limited its examination to a sample of overseas exporters.

This notification is to inform all parties of a proposed expansion in the previously selected sample.

Based on the information available to the TRA, the proposed expanded sample has been determined by selecting the overseas exporter who exported the largest volume of the goods concerned from the People's Republic of China to the UK during the period of investigation (1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022) and was not previously included in the sample.

The proposed expansion of the sample of overseas exporters will now include **Weifang Goldshield Tire Co., Ltd.** Each of the companies within the group, will be sent a questionnaire once the sample is finalised.

The TRA seeks to consult on this proposal and invites comment on the expanded sample.
