



**Anti-dumping investigation No. AD0059: Certain engine oils and hydraulic fluids from Lithuania and the United Arab Emirates.  
Notification of final sample**

**Domestic producer sampling**

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) received nine registrations of interest from domestic producers during the registration process.

In accordance with Regulation 57(2)(d) of The Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019<sup>1</sup>, the TRA will limit its examination to a sample of domestic producers. Given the number of registrations received, the TRA considers that examining all domestic producers would be unduly burdensome and would prevent the timely completion of the investigation.

The TRA published the [notice of proposed sample](#) on 8 August 2024. The TRA received one submission in response to this proposed sample, from Lubriage Ltd, that is [available on the public file](#).

The sample is based on the largest volumes of production reported by the domestic producers, and will include the following 4 domestic producers:

Name	Production volume in the PoI (megalitres)
Paterson Enterprises Ltd	17-20
Aztec Oil	10-15
Granville Oil & Chemicals Ltd	5-10
Ferguson & Menzies Ltd	6-9

Sampled domestic producers will be expected to provide adequate responses to questionnaires and allow the TRA to verify the data provided.
