TRANSITION REVIEW No. TD0035

Anti-dumping duties on certain pneumatic tyres used for buses or lorries originating in the People's Republic of China

Notification of proposed sample - exporters

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has previously notified that the number of responses received in both the registration period and to the pre-sampling questionnaire means the TRA has limited its examination to a sample of overseas exporters.

On 22 August 2023, the TRA published a notification of expansion of this initial sample.

This notification is to inform all parties of a further proposed expansion to the sample.

In order to maximise the relevant information available for the review, **the TRA proposes to expand the sample to include all exporters registered to the case.** Registered overseas producers of the like goods that did not export during the period of investigation **are also required to submit exporter questionnaire responses.**

The TRA seeks to consult on this proposal and invites comment on the expanded sample. The non-confidential version of comments received will be published on the public file.
