



## DUMPING INVESTIGATION - CASE No. AD0086

### Rutile titanium dioxide originating from the People's Republic of China Notification of proposed sample

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has decided to limit the issuing of questionnaires to a sample of certain interested parties in accordance with regulations 54(4) and 56 of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations) to determine whether the goods concerned have or are being dumped into the UK.

All sampled interested parties and any intermediary companies involved in sales to the UK will be expected to provide adequate responses to questionnaires and allow the TRA to verify the data provided.

In accordance with regulation 56(4) of the Regulations, the TRA publishes this notification to provide details of its sampling approach and the proposed sample of overseas exporters. The TRA invites overseas exporters and any other interested parties or contributors to provide comments regarding the sampling methodology and the proposed sample, using [the TRS portal](#), on or before 7 April 2026. The TRA will consider these comments before publishing a final sampling decision.

#### Overseas exporter sampling

Based on the information available to the TRA, and considering associations between groups of exporters, the proposed sample is composed of the following overseas exporters:

##### Lomon Billions Group:

- LB Sichuan Titanium Industry Co., LTD
- Henan Billions Advanced Material Co., LTD
- LB Lufeng Titanium Co., LTD
- LB Xiangyang Titanium Industry Co., LTD
- LB Group Co., LTD

##### Lubei Group:

- Shandong Jinhai Titanium Resources Technology Co., LTD
- Shandong Xianghai Titanium Co., LTD

Each of the companies mentioned above, within a group, will be sent an individual questionnaire. In accordance with Regulation 56(3) of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019, the proposed sample is based on the largest volume of exports from the People's Republic of China to the UK that the TRA is reasonably able to investigate.
