### Note to public file regarding a clarification in the exporter questionnaire for TD0034.

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) have received a request for clarification regarding the PCN table in the questionnaires.

Following the request, the TRA has decided to issue a clarification relating to the Product Control Number (PCN) table as follows:

Query Raised	Clarification provided
<p>Product Control Numbers:</p> <p>“According to the PCN table, a complete PCN should contain 14 digits in total. However, the sample PCN listed under the PCN table, i.e. 161912AB6B21E, contains only 13 digits. We find the difference is possibly due to “Diameter of rope”. In PCN table the field format for diameter is “NNN” (3 digits), but in sample PCN the diameter appears as “21” (2 digits). We’d like to have your clarification whether we should follow the PCN table or the sample PCN.”</p>	<p>Product Control Numbers:</p> <p>“The example PCN is incorrect. A full PCN should contain 14 digits in total, including 3 digits for the diameter. The sample PCN should therefore read 161912AB6B021E (emphasis added) ”.</p>
