

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EXPAND MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED

Safeguard measure on certain steel products

Tariff Rate Quota Review

Case No. TQ0066

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) provides notice in accordance with regulation 36(2) of The Trade Remedies (Increase in Imports Causing Serious Injury to UK Producers) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations) that it intends to expand the matters to be considered in this review, pursuant to regulation 36(1).

The TRA intends to consider the following matters, in relation to the TRQ measures imposed on all importers, in its review:

- The fact that the tariff rate quota, or any part of the quota, has been exhausted; and
- A change in demand for the relevant goods

This is in addition to the matters relating to the developing country exceptions that were included in the Notice of Initiation made on 28 February 2025.

Interested parties have the opportunity to comment on this prior to the TRA formally expanding the matters to be considered. Comments should be submitted through the [Trade Remedies Service](#) by 23:59 UK time **25 March 2025**.
