1. Please describe the role of your company in relation to the goods subject to review, like goods or directly competitive goods:

As only one of a few European steel manufacturers capable of providing rail to relevant standards to a number of Rail Authorities, we have been a Tier 1 supplier to the UK Infrastructure market for some years, providing some sections in competition with domestic producers and some sections not produced in the UK.

2. Please describe your interest in this case:

We have over a number of years supported the UK Rail network and its subcontractors in the supply of material and expertise and at the request of Network Rail, have acted swiftly and decisively to mitigate any risk to the network, as a result of the financial difficulties experienced with the domestic Producer.

In these uncertain times, as the largest of only a small number of producers able to manufacture these products to the exacting standards for both quality and safety, I feel the safeguarding measures should be re-addressed or revoked completely.

I also believe steel safeguarding tariffs will have a detrimental effect to domestic producers exporting to the EEC, making this valuable market harder to access, resulting in further financial burden.
