We are a producer of agricultural fencing products in the UK. We consume steel wire from category 28 of the safeguard measures in our UK operation, converting the raw material into finished fencing products.

2. Please describe your interest in this case:

We have noted that some of the TARIC groups within product category 28 (Non-Alloy Wire) have been included in the UK measures but have not had domestic production in the UK since 2017. The inclusion of these products in the measures could have serious detrimental effects on the price of our raw material to produce these products in the UK. We then face unfair competition of unlimited importation of finished goods with no threat of a quota

The products which have been included in the UK safeguard measures but do not have domestic production fall under the following TARIC groups:

7217 20 – Plated or coated with Zinc

7217 30 – Plated or coated with other base metals

7217 90 – Other

Therefore, according to the WTO Agreement on Safeguards, the following TARICs have been included but should not be covered by the UK safeguard measures:
