The MEGASA group (Megasa Siderúrgica, SN Maia, SN Seixal), based in Spain and Portugal, is a very steady supplier of rebar, wire rod and merchant bars to the United Kingdom.

2. Please describe your interest in this case:

We have had a steady presence in the UK market for the past three decades and it is probably fair to say that in the past decade we have been the main EU rebar, rebar in coil and mesh supplier to the independent rebar fabricators in this country,

Any increase in EU sales to the UK between 2015 and 2017 must be looked at in the context of a recovery of market share after the flood of Chinese rebar that ended up leading to anti-dumping measures in 2016. After that moment there was a return to normality (traditional flows) based on market's needs, and ever since any increase of our sales has been in response to the natural growth of the UK rebar market and the needs of the independent fabricators.
