According to the decision of the UK authority a tariff rate quota will apply from January 1, 2021 in relation to imports into the United Kingdom of goods belonging to certain steel product categories, *inter alia*, originating in Ukraine.

2. Please describe your interest in this case:

As the government entity Department for Domestic Producer Defence (DPD) is an independent structural unit of the Ministry for Development of Economy, Trade and Agriculture of Ukraine. In its work, DPD is guided by legal acts of Ukraine. The DPD is responsible for the domestic producers' trade interests protection on foreign markets during conducting of anti-dumping, anti-subsidy or safeguard investigations/reviews in regards to goods of Ukrainian origin.

Ukraine has been a historical and responsible supplier of steel products to its EU customers, including in the UK. An adjustment of the measures, if decided by the TRID to implement, should not prevent traditional trade flows of steel products to the UK from Ukraine. Ukrainian side considers that the prolongation of safeguard measures on certain steel product categories in this case is questionable taking into account that original safeguard investigation was not concluded by the UK authorities.
