### Certain Excavators exported from the People's Republic of China

#### Notification of proposed change to PCN structure

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has reassessed the PCN structure following questionnaire comments from Interested Parties.

Following an assessment of domestic and overseas production the TRA has identified the need for a greater distinction between the larger types of excavators. This will allow for a more detailed analysis between the goods concerned and the like goods.

The TRA proposes to use the updated PCN structure below. The changes include an upper limit to category 'XL', and the addition of two new categories 'XXL' and 'XXXL'.

| Category | Description                        | Basic Operating Weight       |
|----------|------------------------------------|------------------------------|
| S        | Small Excavators                   | $\geq 11$ tonnes < 15 tonnes |
| M        | Medium Excavators                  | $\geq 15$ tonnes < 20 tonnes |
| L        | Large Excavators                   | $\geq 20$ tonnes < 30 tonnes |
| XL       | Extra-Large Excavators             | $\geq 30$ tonnes < 55 tonnes |
| XXL      | Extra-Extra-Large Excavators       | $\geq 55$ tonnes < 80 tonnes |
| XXXL     | Extra-Extra-Extra-Large Excavators | $\geq 80$ tonnes             |
