## Publication of documents - Note to Public File

### Note to the public file summarising publication of pre-sampling questionnaire and registration forms

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) issued deficiency notices to several parties following review of their submitted pre-sampling questionnaire and registration forms (PSQs.) A deadline of 14 April was provided to parties for submission of revised PSQs addressing these deficiencies.

By this deadline, no further submissions had been received by the following parties:

- GRP Solutions Ltd
- Brett Martin Daylight Systems (BMDS)

These parties' documents were deemed deficient<sup>1</sup> due to over-redaction in the non-confidential response, of information which was provided in the parties' confidential submissions.

Therefore, while the TRA is still seeking revised submissions from GRP Solutions and BMDS, we have taken the decision to publish the deficient non-confidential versions of these documents. The TRA may disregard the confidential information which was over-redacted by these parties in the non-confidential version, unless we receive a further sufficient non-confidential submission,<sup>2</sup> or we can satisfy ourselves that such information is correct from appropriate sources.
