Anti-Dumping Investigation concerning Biodiesel originating from the
People's Republic of China

Notice of Request for Information concerning scope

The TRA invite Interested Parties to provide their assessment on whether Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) should be included within the scope of this investigation. This request is in response to recent enquiries where it has been brought to our attention that:

- (a) The definition of the goods subject to investigation could be interpreted as including SAF; and
- (b) Importers use a variety of commodity codes in relation to SAF which may sometimes include commodity codes that are used for Hydrotreated Vegetable Oil (HVO).

Interested parties are invited to provide views and supporting evidence on the scope of the investigation. Where supporting evidence includes information of a confidential nature, parties should ensure that they also provide a non-confidential version.
