**Countervailing duties on imports of continuous filament glass fibre products
originating in Egypt**

Proposal to expand the issues to be considered in a scope review

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

Following the initiation of Scope Review SC0039, the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) is proposing to expand the issues to be considered in the review to include all four commodity codes relating to mats made of glass fibre filaments excluding mats of glass wool.

**EXPANSION OF THE ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED TO INCLUDE ALL
COMMODITY CODES FOR MATS**

Under Regulation 68 of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations), the TRA is considering expanding the issues to be considered in the review to include all four commodity codes for mats made of glass fibre filaments excluding mats of glass wool, rather than just considering the one commodity code referred to in the Application. This will allow the TRA to assess whether the scope of the measure should be varied and to what extent.

In accordance with Regulation 68(2), the TRA invites comments from interested parties and contributors during the consultation period of 7 July – 22 July 2023. After considering any comments from interested parties and contributors, if the TRA determines to expand the issues to be considered, we will issue an amended Notice of Initiation under Regulation 41(6).

The goods subject to review are:

mats made of glass fibre filaments excluding mats of glass wool

The goods subject to review are subject to the following commodity code:

70 19 14 00 90

The proposal is to include the following additional commodity codes within the goods subject to review:

70 19 14 00 10

70 19 15 00 10

70 19 15 00 90
