Overseas Exporter Questionnaire Annex 1

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) is informing overseas exporters in the People's Republic of China (PRC) of corrections to the following two tabs within Annex 1:

- "D8) CTM in domestic market"; and
- "D9) AS&G in domestic market".

Sampled overseas exporters in the PRC are requested to complete the new version of Annex 1 as part of their questionnaire response.

D8) CTM in domestic market

- The old version (in both Table A and Table B) incorrectly included columns for the following raw materials: steel, hydraulics, electrical parts, engines, batteries, plastics, and traction.
These have now been replaced with the raw materials for glass containers, namely: limestone, silica sand, soda ash, and external (post-consumer) cullet.
- We also added a separate column for direct energy costs.

D9) AS&G in domestic market

- The old version only included placeholders for various selling costs and administrative and general costs.
The new version now includes: indirect energy costs, land costs, finance costs, R&D costs, and other waste disposal costs.
