Questionnaire Clarification

Waste disposal costs

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) is informing interested parties of a request for information. Within the exporter and foreign government questionnaires the TRA has sought information relating to the potential particular market situation (PMS) on waste disposal. This has been referred to as 'coal waste disposal' in the PMS section of the questionnaire. The TRA is clarifying that this request is in relation to all waste disposal in the production of the like goods and/or the goods concerned.

Sampled exporters

The TRA published a proposed sample with a period for consultation. During this consultation, Lubei group [requested to be removed from the sample](#). The TRA decided to decline this request and the [published notice of final sample](#) retained the Lubei group companies. Subsequently, and after the consultation period had closed and the note of final sample had been published, LB group [made a submission](#) requesting two of the LB group companies be removed from the sample. The TRA have decided to decline this request as well.

The sample as published in the note of final sample therefore remains as the final sampling decision of the TRA.

All of the exporters named in the [published notice of final sample](#) are expected to return a questionnaire response. Failure to do so without good reason may be viewed as a lack of cooperation with this investigation, in line with the [note published to the public file](#).
