Anti-dumping Investigation on Biodiesel originating from the People's Republic of China

Note to Public File – Registration of third country producers

Further to the [note to public file](#) published on 27 September 2024, outlining the TRA's proposal to use Malaysia as a representative third country should it be required, we would like to invite producers in Malaysia to participate and assist with this investigation by providing certain sales and cost data.

We will treat this information as confidential and will also ask for a non-confidential version or summary of the information to be provided, so that we can publish this on our public file.

If multiple producers choose to participate, we may use an appropriate sampling methodology to select who to involve further. If you are a producer in Malaysia and would like to participate in the investigation, please register your interest by completing and submitting a Third Country Producer Pre-Sampling Questionnaire (PSQ) via the [Trade Remedies Service](#) by **18 October 2024**. A copy of the relevant Third Country Producer PSQ is attached with this note.

Please note that the TRA has extended the timeframe for comments on the TRA's provisional choice of appropriate representative country until 17 October 2024. This invitation for registration by Malaysian producers does not prejudice the TRA's final decision on the proposal to use Malaysia as a representative third country should it be required, a final decision on which has yet to be taken.
