Jinyu Tire begins TBR production at Vietnamese facility

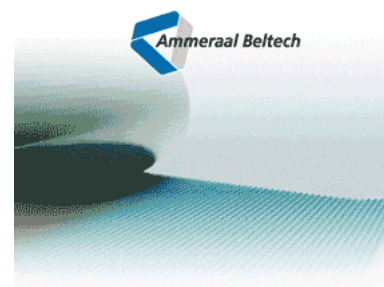


Tire manufacturer Jinyu Tire has begun production of its first truck and bus radial (TBR) tires at its new factory in Vietnam, which will have the capacity to produce up to two million tires annually.

During nine months of construction during the country's rainy season and the Covid-19 pandemic, 19 buildings were built covering an area of 130,000m². The tire maker also installed the equipment and other facilities needed to complete the production line, ready for volume manufacturing to begin in May.

The Vietnam facility is Jinyu's first overseas production base, and features a range of automatic safety control systems to ensure continuous improvement.
