**Comment on the Statement of Essential Facts regarding Transition review of anti-dumping duties applying to certain Ceramic Tableware and Kitchenware products originating in the People's Republic of China (PRC)
Review No. TD0056**

Dear Investigator,

This Comment is made with regard to the Statement of Essential Facts (hereinafter as “SEF”) published on the Trade Remedy Service on 12 June 2025, according to which interested parties are invited to submit comments before 23:59 (UK time) on 3 July 2025.

We understand the Trade Remedies Authority (hereinafter as “TRA”) intends to recommend that the Secretary of State for Business and Trade extends the measure on the Ceramic Tableware and Kitchenware products (hereinafter as “CT&K”) originating in the PRC for another 5 years until 16 July 2029.

We also understand the TRA considers it did not receive compelling evidence providing appropriate reasons for recalculation of the anti-dumping amounts, and the limitation of data received from interested parties made it not possible to recalculate the anti-dumping amount nor the injury margin. Therefore, the TRA intends to recommend maintaining the anti-dumping amounts applicable to the CT&K subject to this transition review.

We found in Annex 1, Annex 2 and Annex 3 of the SEF listing the duty amount of additional TAP codes for PRC exporters involved in this transition review. However, we found several exporters not listed in those three Annexes. We would like to reiterate that these exporters have submitted Pre-Sampling Questionnaire and have been listed in the Notification of final sample published on 1 July 2024, including:

Upon submission of Pre-Sampling Questionnaire, those above exporters should be considered as cooperating (but not selected within the sample) in this transition review. We respectfully request [Sensitive – exporters] to be listed in Annex 3 for duty amount of 17.9% as they are cooperating but not sampled exporters.

In addition, we respectfully request the TRA to consider adding a complete list of names of all PRC exporters which have submitted Pre-Sampling Questionnaire as an annex in the SEF and in the notice of Final Recommendation.
