**AS0067 :TRA review of countervailing measures on US renewable diesel**

Dear Sirs

UKOITC is an organisation formed and maintained by tax professionals on behalf of member companies. Our purpose is to share knowledge between members, non-members, and government organisation, and to represent members on industry wide tax matters.

UKOITC member businesses are importers, and non-UK producers, of HVO (as Goods Concerned and Like Goods) in the form of:

- Renewable diesel (HVO)
- co-processed diesel
- SAF (including renewable diesel to be processed into SAF)

Except for Mabanft and Greenergy, UKOITC represents all the largest downstream oil companies. Any trade measures effecting HVO impacts UKOITC member businesses' cost and ability to import, the pricing of internal UK sales and the desire of UK customers to purchase sustainable hydrocarbons.

These matters further impact UKOITC members ability to meet RTFO and SAF mandates and may negatively impact member's ability to contribute to the UK's net zero targets.

For the purpose of time and expediency, UKOITC confirms its support for the non-confidential submission made by Phillips 66. The paper was prepared on an industry basis to support open trade and to promote and protect UKOITC Member interests set out above. However, it also looks to ensure that the TRA approach fully considers all factors impacting the industry and which must be considered for a fair decision to be made on the calculation of CVDs.

The comments in that document are representative of UKOITC Member's views.
