MILENYUM METAL'S COMMENTS ON SCOPE CHANGE

The Trade Remedies Authority published proposal to amend the scope of the subsidy investigation on 21 October 2022.

The TRA proposed to revise the scope to include additional subsidy programmes in the investigation which are described as “preferential financing through equity and other capital instruments, and provision of preferential export credit and insurance provided by the Government of the Republic of Türkiye and other state-owned entities, including banks.”

The TRA's initial assessment pursuant to Regulation 41(5) of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 is that:

- It is likely the TRA would have initiated its investigation with a revised scope had this information been available in the application.
- The proposed revision does not cause any prejudice to the interests of any interested party or contributor.
- The proposed revision will not prevent the TRA from proceeding with the investigation expeditiously.

Milenyum Metal cooperated with the TRA in this investigation starting from the initiation stage. In this respect, Milenyum Metal provided all information available related to possible subsidies in its responses to the exporter-producer questionnaire, and answered questions or provided documentation during the verification visit.

Milenyum Metal shall continue to cooperate with the TRA in the following stages of this investigation.
