

OBJECTION TO SAMPLE SELECTION FOR TD0061

Brompton Bicycle Limited wishes to formally object to the sample selections for the Anti-Dumping Transition Review number TD0061 on the following points, as it believes without being addressed the investigation may be flawed.

UK Producer Sampling

1. So far Brompton has identified over XX UK manufacturers of varying scales who would be directly impacted by any outcome from this review as well as their UK supply chain.
2. With the exclusion of Brompton, folding bikes have to all intents and purposes been excluded from the sample. This is a key and growing part of the UK manufacturing landscape


We would request that the TRA confirm that the data provided from unsampled companies will be given weight to those sampled.

UK Importer Sampling

1. We question whether a EIT case can be relied upon where the UK importers are not sampled for verification and object to this disparity. Without sampling any outcome could be subject to a future challenge
2. Further, we have noted that a company has been permitted to be part of the process whilst remaining anonymous. This has not been offered to the manufacturers and we question why this special treatment has been provided. Without clarification such unequal treatment could render any future result subject to challenge.

We request a response from the TRA on these two points.
