Re: AS0046 – Additional evidence of injury caused by imports of Chinese Excavators
Our client: JCB Heavy Products Limited ("Applicant")

We refer to ongoing anti-subsidy investigation by the UK Trade Remedies Authority ("**TRA**") on UK imports of certain excavators ("**Excavators**") originating in China ("**Investigations**").¹

As the Applicant demonstrated, imports of Chinese Excavators cause severe injury to the Applicant, including through cutthroat pricing.²

With this submission, the Applicant adds to the record [*CONFIDENTIAL – Description of evidence*] which in turn reflect price depression and price suppression. The intention is to illustrate to the TRA how the extremely low prices of Chinese Excavators distort the UK Excavator market.

In sum, Chinese Excavator manufacturers' aggressive pricing strategies have caused, and continue to increasingly cause after the period of investigation, significant material injury to the Applicant.
