The Government of Indonesia (The "GOI") would like to thank you for your response letter dated 16 May 2025 for the transition review investigation on the imposition of Countervailing Duty (CVD) on Biodiesel imports from Indonesia.

As we advised you earlier, Indonesia has not exported biodiesel, and due to the increase in demand for biodiesel in Indonesia, we also do not anticipate any export of biodiesel from Indonesia to the United Kingdom.
