



NOTICE OF INITIATION

Reconsideration of original decision in a subsidy investigation relating to ironing boards from the Republic of Türkiye.

Investigation No. AS0020

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) makes the following notice under regulation 12(1) of The Trade Remedies (Reconsideration and Appeals) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations) to initiate a reconsideration of an original decision in Investigation No. AS0020 relating to ironing boards from the Republic of Türkiye.

The date of initiation of the reconsideration is 8 December 2023.

Description of goods to which the reconsideration relates

Ironing boards made from iron or steel, whether or not free-standing, with or without a steam-soaking and/or heating top and/or blowing top, including sleeve boards, and essential parts thereof, i.e., the legs, the top and the iron rest.

The basic product type consists of steel legs, steel top, iron rest and textile cover. The primary use of all product types is the ironing of clothes.

Original Decision to be reconsidered

The TRA will reconsider –

- 1) The [recommendation to the Secretary of State](#) made pursuant to paragraph 17(4) of Schedule 4 to the Taxation (Cross-border Trade) Act 2018 (the Act).
