



## NOTICE OF A RECONSIDERED DECISION

Reconsideration of an original decision in Investigation No. AD0047

**Anti-dumping duties on certain excavators from the People's Republic of China**

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) makes the following Notice under regulation 14(5) of The Trade Remedies (Reconsideration and Appeals) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the Regulations).

Following reconsideration, the TRA has determined that the original decision, namely the [recommendation to the Secretary of State](#) made pursuant to paragraph 17(3) of Schedule 4 to the Taxation (Cross-border Trade) Act 2018, is **upheld**.
