The scope of this investigation

Goods concerned

This investigation covers certain engine oils and hydraulic fluids exported from Lithuania and the United Arab Emirates, described as:

- Certain engine oils and hydraulic fluids. This includes passenger car motor oils, heavy duty commercial vehicle oils and hydraulic oils, grades: 5W-30, 5W-40, 0W-16, 0W-20, 0W-30, 10W-40, 10W-30, 20W-50, S40, S50, 15W-40, ISO32, ISO46, ISO68, HV32, HV46 and HV68.

These goods are currently classifiable within the following commodity codes:

- *ex 27101981*
- *ex 27101983*

These commodity codes are only given for information.

In this document, these goods will be referred to as the goods concerned'. Any reference to 'goods concerned' in this document refers to the goods description above, regardless of the commodity code under which they are exported.

Like goods
