This **investigation** covers certain excavators exported from the PRC, described as:

- *Self-propelled track-laying (i.e., tracked) excavators with a 360° revolving superstructure and with an operating weight of 11,000 kg (i.e., 11 tons) or more.*

These excavators are currently classifiable within the following commodity code 8429 5210 00. This commodity code is only given for information, and includes ‘mini’ excavators under 11 tons.

In this document, these goods will be referred to as ‘the goods concerned.’ Any reference to ‘goods concerned’ in this document refers to the goods description above, regardless of the commodity code under which they are exported.

Like goods

Any reference to ‘like goods’ in this document refers to goods produced in the UK or imported to the UK from a country other than the PRC which are like the goods concerned in all respects, or with characteristics closely resembling them.
