## The scope of this review

### Goods subject to review

This review covers ceramic tiles exported from the People's Republic of China (PRC), described as:

- **Glazed and unglazed ceramic flags and paving, hearth, or wall tiles; and,**
- **Glazed and unglazed ceramic mosaic cubes and the like, whether or not on a backing.**

These ceramic tiles are currently classifiable within the following commodity codes

6907 2100 00	6907 2300 00	6907 4000 00
6907 2200 00	6907 3000 00	

These commodity codes are only given for information.

In this document, these goods will be referred to as **'the goods subject to review'**. Any reference to 'goods subject to review' in this document refers to the goods description above, regardless of the commodity code under which they are exported.

### Like goods

Any reference to 'like goods' in this document refers to goods produced in the UK or imported to the UK from a country other than the PRC which are like the goods subject to review in all respects, or with characteristics closely resembling them.

### B2 – Particular Market Situation

CCCMC raises particular concern about the compatibility of the anti-dumping measures, previously imposed on the imports of the goods under investigation by the European Union ("EU") and carried over by the United Kingdom ("UK") after the UK ceased to be a member of the EU on 1 January 2021, with the WTO agreements and in particular the Anti-dumping Agreement, in the absence of a proper new investigation conducted in line with the latter agreement beforehand. Consequently, the legality of the present review investigation of the said measures is also questionable.

CCCMC also submits that there is no positive evidence indicating the existence of a particular market situation in the Chinese domestic market as far as the goods subject to review are concerned. Therefore, the investigating authority shall follow the general rules to determine the normal value of the like goods, i.e. based on the domestic sales prices and cost of Chinese exporting producers.



CCCMC reserves the right to present its views on the absence of injurious status of UK producers of the like goods, and no likelihood of recurrence of dumping and injury if the existing anti-dumping measures are lapsed, once more information is available to it.

In any event, CCCMC strongly believes that any extension of the existing anti-dumping measures will not be in the economic interests of the UK, nor in its public interests, given the current economic recovery need amid the supply chain disruption caused by the global pandemic.
