In its capacity as the trade association of the UK steel sector, it represents the interests of the UK producers of the goods subject to this review.*

*UK Steel represents the interests of the UK’s steel producing companies, including those of the goods subject to this review. UK Steel welcomes the opening of this developing country exception review for Category 13 – Rebar of the UK steel safeguards. We also welcome the TRA’s proposal to expand the scope of the review to all safeguard categories and all developing country exceptions.*

*This will ensure that the developing country exceptions to the steel safeguards are as up to date as possible and reflecting the most recent changes in trade flows. This is also in line with our previous request to the TRA for a schedule of regular reviews, to prevent the developing country exceptions to be taken advantage of by certain countries and to make sure that safeguards perform their intended function of curbing surges in imports.*

By the time the TRA performs its data analysis, it will have import data for the full period of investigation January-December 2022. Based on the currently available data for January-November 2022 and on UK Steel’s analysis, we would expect the following revocations of developing country exceptions as their import share is above the 3% threshold.
