Jindal Shadeed Iron and Steel (JSIS) is based in Sohar , Oman and currently manufactures about 2.4 million MT of steel per year, out of which about 1.40 million MT is rebars.

As JSIS is based in Oman, its natural market is [REDACTED]. Over the years JSIS has been well accepted in local and export markets due the good quality and the reliability of supplies. As our steel making process is Natural-Gas based DRI –EAF, JSIS has one of the lowest Carbon foot print of 1.05 ton of Carbon for every ton of steel made which is well below the global average.
